Creepy Critters Kindergarten to Grade 2

Learn to appreciate some misunderstood creatures with a hands-on snake talk and guided nature hike.

Polywogs 'n Frogs Grade 1 and up

Become acquainted with wetland dwellers through a hands-on search for aquatic creatures and a life cycle study.

Chrysalids & Cocoons Grade 1 and up

Learn the many amazing characteristics, adaptations and lifecycles of our six-legged friends and participate in a "signs of insects" hike.

Ecosystems Exploration Grade 3 and up

Students record observations as they hike through wooded areas, peer into ponds and discover new habitats. Special attention is paid to the plants and animals that make up these communities
