Two Parks to Close Temporarily

The City of Windsor will temporarily close Black Oak Heritage Park and Broadway Park, including the dog park, due to construction in the area.

Work on a new bridge plaza will affect Broadway Street, which is the only access road for the parks.

The closures will take effect on Tuesday December 1, 2015.

Other nearby natural areas to explore includes Ojibway Park and Tallgrass Prairie Heritage Park, while the closest dog parks would be Optimist Park and Remington Park.

There's no word yet on how long the closures will be necessary.
